City of Boscobel Tree Replacement Program

The City of Boscobel is interested in partnering with City residents to help replace trees that had to be removed the past couple of years and ones that will need to be removed in the foreseeable future. Interested participants will be able to pick up a tree voucher at City Hall. City Residents who have had tree(s) removed out of the right-of-way may be eligible for a reimbursement up to \$50.00 per tree replaced.

If you are a City Resident and are interested in partnering with us for the Tree Replacement Program, please contact City Hall at (608) 375-5001 to discuss eligibility and requirements. Once approved, you will be given a Voucher to submit with your receipt of purchase after the eligible tree is planted.

- 1. City Residents can receive 50% of the cost of an eligible tree up to \$50.00 maximum.
- 2. City Residents may qualify for up to two (2) rebates based upon the # of trees taken down by City Crews.
- 3. This program is intended to replace trees that have been removed out of the right-of-way and will run until all funds are expended.
- 4. Street Superintendent, Luke Brown, and/or DPW, Mike Reynolds will determine if tree type and location meet guidelines for reimbursement and will verify tree has been planted before authorizing payment.
