Swim Team is especially for those youth who LOVE to swim and who might enjoy swimming in competition against other teams! Coaches are not expected to instruct but rather focus on 4 basic strokes and work to help swimmers develop and improve those swimming skills. ## Swim Lesson Information

### Description of Swim Levels

The Levels are presented in a logical progression. It is not unusual for swimmers to stay at a certain level for a few times before they can successfully complete all the skills at that particular level. It is natural for children to develop skills and comfort levels at different paces.

**Parent-Tot:** (at least 6 months to 3 years) This class is for mom or dad and their child to have fun together in the water! A parent must accompany the child in the water and participate. We hope to help young children be more comfortable in the water so they will be ready to learn to swim. We teach by singing songs, playing games, and learning to blow bubbles, floating, etc., while being supported by a parent.

**Pre-School Swimmer (PSS):** for children ages 4 & 5 years old who are ready to participate in a group setting **without** a parent. They learn Level 1 skills.

**Level 1:** ages 6 and up. **Water Exploration.** Students learn water entry and exit, breath control and submerging, buoyancy, changing direction and position and swimming on stomach/chest and back.

**Level 2: Primary Skills**

**Level 3: Stroke Readiness**

**Level 4: Stroke Development**

**Level 5: Stroke Refinement**

**Level 6: Skill Proficiency and “Personal Water Safety”**

### ***Swimming Lesson Sessions***

Three Sessions will be offered. You may sign up for one session. Each Session takes approximately 2 weeks; lessons include 9 lessons and one built-in “bad weather” day. If we have to cancel a lesson due to weather/temperature, the lesson is made up on “fun day”.
